NON-COMPLIANCE and 12 POINT SUSPENSION LIMITED DRIVING PRIVILEGES

Contact the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) at 330-471-1108 or go to the BMV Reinstatement Office located at 306 Second Street, SE in Canton to find out the type of suspension on your license and any reinstatement requirements and fees due at the BMV.

Driving privileges are not granted on a judgment suspension. You will need to contact the BMV for information about the judgment or contact the Court where the judgment was granted.

The Court has a Petition form available in the Civil Division. The Civil Division is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and on our website at [www.cityofbarberton.com /clerkofcourts](http://www.cityofbarberton.com/clerkofcourts) under the Forms tab.

A 1:00 p.m. hearing date will be set before a Judge. If you file your petition after your suspension begins, you are not permitted to drive pending your court date.

If you are unable to pay your reinstatement fees to the BMV you can petition the court for an installment payment plan for the reinstatement fees due at the time you file your Petition for Limited Driving Privileges.

The Following Must Accompany the Form Required for Applying for Driving Privileges:

1. A copy of the Notice of Suspension from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles.
2. A \$50.00 filing fee is required (\$100.00 if you are filing for a non-compliance suspension and live outside of the Barberton Municipal Court District). Bring a check or money order made payable to the Barberton Municipal Court or cash.
3. You must provide proof that all of your reinstatement fees due to the BMV have been paid in full or you must petition the court for an installment payment plan for the reinstatement fees due at the time you file your Petition.
4. A copy of your paid in full SR 22 bond for the entire period of your suspension must also be provided to the Court.
